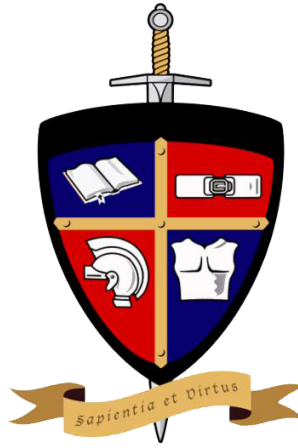
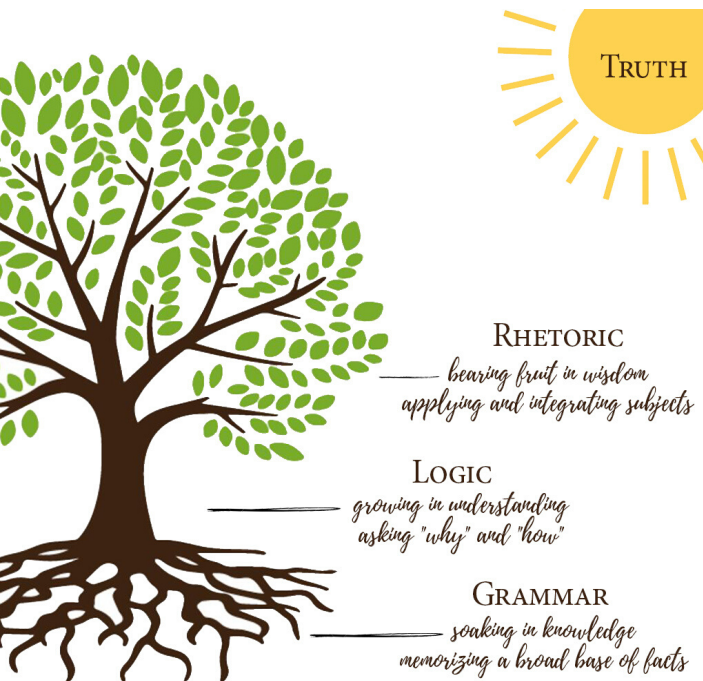


WHAT IS CLASSICAL CHRISTIAN EDUCATION?

Our Kindergarten program is a place where the soil is prepared for formal learning, where the seeds of academic mastery are planted, and where children flourish and grow.

The classroom experience is designed to foster spiritual, cognitive, physical, and social development of God's precious children through guided discovery and exploration.

In preparing these young students for our Grammar School and a lifetime of learning, we fully utilize their development stage which is characterized by both a sense of wonder and natural ability to learn through imitation. Therefore, singing, memorizing, chanting, playing, moving, exploring, and discovering are integral to all aspects of our program.

This methodology lays down a strong foundation for the building blocks that are vital for the future of learning and success.



WHAT WILL MY CHILD **LEARN?**



BIBLE STUDY

Students learn to hide God's word in their hearts through the singing of Scripture, memorizing of Bible verses and Catechism, and hearing the re-telling of Bible stories.

LANGUAGE ARTS

We encourage our students to develop a love of reading through instruction in phonics. They are exposed daily to classical children's literature which is read aloud in class. Instruction is provided in phonemic awareness, phonics, handwriting, and spelling in an integrated approach.

MATH

Our math curriculum and manipulatives are designed to provide knowledge and confidence in math skills, most notably number sense. An incremental approach to math, this program provides students with instruction in number recognition, geometric shapes, measuring, estimating, telling time, graphing, basic addition and subtraction.

SCIENCE UNIT STUDIES

Children have a natural curiosity about the world around them, and our science units take advantage of this time in their lives to develop a passion for learning.

HISTORY & GEOGRAPHY

Kindergarten is an exciting time to start exploring God's world! Students start with knowledge about themselves and the communities in which they live. They then move on to studying their State, their Country, and begin to study different countries around the world.

ART

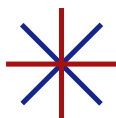

MUSIC & STORYTIME
